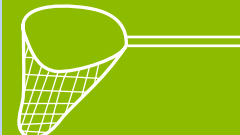
**Urban Dynamics - Green Square** is a Geography fieldwork program that focuses on the urban dynamics of urban consolidation and renewal in the Green Square development precinct.

Students will view a number of Green Square development sites, including the new Green Square Town Centre, and Victoria Park, to identify and investigate the urban dynamics of renewal and consolidation. They will also learn about how Green Square's renewal and consolidation is helping to achieve the goals of the Sydney Metropolitan Plan 2036 to slow urban sprawl and make Sydney a more compact city.



The program has three main components:

1. **Introductory activities, including a comprehensive presentation on Green square to familiarise students with the study site and fieldwork concepts covered.**
2. **A whole day fieldwork experience at Town Hall (when available) & Green Square.**
3. **Follow up activities to enhance geographical knowledge and skills, including a variety of resources about Green Square.**
