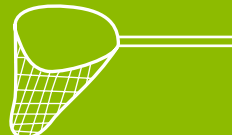
Urban Dynamics - Barangaroo is a S6 Geography fieldwork program that focuses on the urban dynamics of consolidation and renewal in Barangaroo, and gentrification in Millers Point.

Students will visit Barangaroo to identify and investigate the urban dynamics of renewal and consolidation and learn about how these dynamics are helping to achieve the goals of the Sydney Metropolitan Plan 2036 to slow urban sprawl and make Sydney a more compact city. Students will also visit nearby Millers Point to investigate the urban process of gentrification, and the relationship of this suburb with Barangaroo



The program has three main components:

1. **Introductory activities, including a comprehensive presentation on Barangaroo to familiarise student with the study site and fieldwork concepts covered.**
2. **A whole day fieldwork experience in Barangaroo and Millers Point, including collecting fieldwork data on Centre iPads in order to create a virtual fieldwork map.**
3. **Follow-up activities to enhance geographical knowledge and skills, including a variety of resources about Barangaroo.**
