'Urban Dynamics - Barangaroo' is a Geography fieldwork program that focuses on the urban dynamics of urban consolidation and renewal in Barangaroo, and gentrification in Millers Point.

Students will learn about how Barangaroo's renewal and consolidation is helping to achieve the goals of the Sydney Metropolitan Plan 2036 to slow urban sprawl and make Sydney a more compact city. They will visit Barangaroo to identify and investigate the urban dynamics of renewal and consolidation. Students will also visit nearby Millers Point to investigate the urban process of gentrification.

The program has three main components:

- 1. Introductory activities and resources to introduce the students to the fieldwork.
- 2. A whole day fieldwork experience in Barangaroo and Millers Point.
- 3. Follow up activities to enhance geographical knowledge and skills.

Visit Millers Point to learn about the process of gentrification which has rapidly transformed this suburb and it's community.
